

International Student Program Guidelines

Please carefully read over the following guidelines. Both the student and parents/guardian must sign and date this document and return it with the application.

1. I understand that I must abide by all the guidelines found in The Charles Finney School Parent Student Handbook (available on our website) in regards to academic and behavior standards, along with guardianship, housing and any other rules set forth by the school.
2. I understand that I must abide by Department of Homeland Security regulations.
3. I understand that my acceptance is for one year. My academic progress and behavior will be evaluated each year. The school is not obligated to re-sign my I-20.
4. I understand that I must meet graduation requirements found in the Parent/ Student Handbook to receive a diploma.
5. I understand that I must maintain a full schedule of academic classes in order to remain in status with my student visa.
6. I have read and understand the policies regarding my financial obligations to the school for tuition payments and other assorted fees.
7. I understand that a packed lunch from my host family will be provided unless I choose to purchase a lunch with my own funds.
8. I understand that I may have a laptop or tablet and will follow the guidelines of my homestay family for technology use. Inappropriate use of the internet (viewing pornography or other questionable websites) is not tolerated and may result in program termination.
9. I understand that I should arrive with a cell phone. If this is not possible then one should be purchased in my name, with my funds once I arrive.
10. I have read through and understand the policies regarding a working proficiency in English. I understand that the school will determine the level and degree of English tutoring needed and this will be evaluated at the end of each year.
11. I understand that I may only travel on approved trips that have been submitted for review to the director of the international program.
12. I understand that I need to arrive in time for orientation and that I will not leave until classes are completed and finals have been taken.
13. I understand that I will return home during Christmas and summer break.
14. I understand that International students are not permitted to drive an automobile.
15. I understand that any false information or failure to disclose information during the application process regarding academic, behavior, or any other issues that may limit the student's ability to adjust to the school and culture may result in dismissal from school with no refund.
