Frindle by Andrew Clements


Assignment for Fiction book: Make a Pizza Slice Book Report (see paper)

- 3. Describe any connections you made to the book while reading. Ex. Similar traits or interests, something in the book made you think differently about a topic, etc.
- 4. Evaluate the book. Would you recommend it to a close friend? Why or why not? BE SPECIFIC (what did you like or not like about it?).

Make a Pizza Slice Book Report

 Describe in detail one of the problems in the story. Use lots of detail.

Slice 4 - Solution

 Describe in detail how the problem was solved.

Slice 5 - Summary

 Describe in detail what the Story was about. Make sure to include only important details.

Slice 6 - Title/Author

 Write the title and author of the Story. Make Sure to Spell all the words correctly.
